Zonin, Prosecco (Veneto, Italy) Dry Sparkling

A lively, sparkling wine, very well-balanced and appealing, with the extremely delicate almond note that is typical of Prosecco

Concha Y Toro Frontera, Moscato (Chile) Sweet White

Fresh fruit and floral perfume aromas are complimented by hints of honey. Fresh, lightly sweet on the palate with slight acidity.

Casillero del Diablo (Concha y Toro), Sauvignon Blanc (Chile) Light Intensity White

This wine is balanced with crisp acidity, fresh hints of citrus, peaches and gooseberry. On the palate, the wine is elegant, round, and mouth-filling.

Torres, Verdejo, "Verdeo" (Rueda, Spain) Light Intensity White

Silky and smooth, it offers clean floral notes such as lemon blossoms, accompanied by citrus flavors and a touch of fennel.

Los Cardos, Chardonnay (Mendoza, Argentina) Medium Intensity White

Filled with intense tropical fruit aromas such as pineapple and mango, with a taste showing great volume and concentration with a mineral and citric finish.

Natura, Rose (Rapel Valley, Chile) Medium Intensity Rose

This organic, Syrah, Cabernet, and Merlot, wine has intense fruity aromas, such as cherry and black currant. Tremendously fresh, fruity, and balanced. Delicate and easy to drink.

Martin Codax, Tempranillo, "Ergo" (Rioja, Spain) Medium Intensity Red

Complex wine, of Tempranillo and Garnacha, with fresh, vibrant aromas of ripe fruit. Sweet dark cherry and vanilla flavors, framed by bright acidity, lingering finish.

Trivento, Cabernet Sauvignon, "Reserve" (Mendoza, Argentina) Medium Intensity Red

Deep red with violet hues. Hints of black currant, pepper and red fruits, with chocolate and coffee notes. Full-bodied, rounded with sweet tannins and a lingering finish.

Las Rocas, Garnacha (Calatayud, Spain) Medium Intensity Red

Vibrant aromas and flavors of dark cherry and blackberry. Integrated nuances of oak and round tannins deliver underscore these decadent fruit flavors to create a rich well structured wine.

Alamos, Malbec (Mendoza, Argentina) Medium Intensity Red

A classically Argentine wine blends the plum flavors of the country's signature variety, with small portions of Syrah and Bonarda to add dark cherry and blackberry flavors, with deep tannins and a long finish.
